3) Research Methodology

Figure 1 and Section 4.2 demonstrate DSR from other scholars, but it is unclear whether or not the author(s) build his methodology for the research. Please highlight the research methodology - not only mentioning the work of others.

4) The to-be-developed System Architecture

What is the relation between the system architecture proposed and the research methodology presented in the previous section

5) Conclusion

The author(s) should clarify the focal point of the paper; touting the work as proof that the method can be applied to solve the problem posed in the paper, as the term, in conclusion, is used rather too broadly.
