ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

- Abstract should consist of background, data and methodology, potential contribution to knowledge, and keywords.
- Abstract should be in English, as also the full paper.
- Paper sessions are seminar-style for each paper and ample time for discussion and for participants to provide constructive feedback to authors.
- Oral and poster presentations will be in English.

POSTER SUBMISSION

- Poster should be 150 x 90 cm.
- Poster should be printed in colour on vinyl paper. Poster should be readable from 2 m distance.
